The **Grab a Book, Gorge a Cake**, program encourages students to read 3 books a month and write their reviews. Young readers are rewarded with a box of cake as a token of appreciation.

DEAR-Drop Everything and Read ensures that everybody in the school drops everything else to pick up a book for a few minutes during the day, devoting a good 80 minutes per week towards reading.

The school's **Book Fair** provides an accessible platform to explore a wide range of books, catering to diverse interests and reading levels.

The **Shakespeare Club** of the school organizes author visits and storytelling sessions allowing students to delve into the world of words beyond classrooms. The school also prioritizes the integration of reading materials into the curriculum, selecting texts that captivate and challenge students, while fostering a lifelong habit of exploring written words.
